First — Federal Court Hearing

The hearing in the U.S. District Court in Madison was held today at 10:00 a.m.

The Association asked the Federal Court to transfer the Tribal Court proceedings filed against the White Sand Lake Association to Federal Court and to allow the reopening of the Association's public landing.
